

- Please fill out BOTH sides of the enrollment form. The medical/emergency information on the back is required by the diocese.
- **KSU basketball fans:** please enroll your child accordingly so that they do not miss their K-8 Religious Ed. This is an opportunity for you, as parents, to show your children that your faith is a priority.
- Registration is required for Preschool, Kindergarten-Grade 6, Junior Youth Ministry (Grades 7-8), and Senior Youth Ministry (Grades 9-12). No enrollment is required for Children's Liturgy (Kindergarten-Grade 4) that occurs during the school year at the 10:30 a.m. Mass.
- Registration deadline is August 23. Tuition is due with registration. Fee schedule:
 - o Before August 23: \$35 (1 child), \$70 (2 children), 3 or more children \$100 cap.
 - After August 23: \$45 (1 child), \$80 (2 children), 3 or more children \$110 cap
 - o Scholarships are available. Contact the Parish Office at 776-5151.

Description of available classes:

PRE-SCHOOL (children ages 3 and 4) - Sunday at 10:30 a.m., Hake Education Wing

- Children must be 3 years old before Sept. 1st.
- Parents: you are <u>required to help in your child's classroom once each semester</u>. You <u>will not have to teach</u>, just provide extra hands in the classroom for the teacher.
- Class begins September 10.

KINDERGARTEN - GRADE SIX - Wednesday, Hake Education Wing

- There are three sessions: 4:10-5:20 p.m., 5:30-6:45 p.m., and 7:00-8:15 p.m.
- Please mark a first and second choice for your child(ren).
- Classes limited to 15 students. Classes are filled on a first come first served basis.
- Class begins September 6.

FIRST COMMUNION CLASSES (Grade 2)

- Children enrolled in the regular Religious Education program and who are in the 2nd grade will be prepared for their First Reconciliation and First Communion.
- The child must have completed a year of 1st grade religion to be eligible.
- Children in 3rd grade who have not received these sacraments will be combined with the 2nd grade for instruction.
- Children in 4th through 8th grade need to enroll in Rite of Christian Initiation of Children classes (RCIC) as well as regular religion classes to prepare to receive the sacraments. Please make a note on the registration form that RCIC is requested.

JUNIOR YOUTH MINISTRY (Grades 7 & 8)

- Meet on Wednesday evenings from 7:00-8:15 p.m. in STM Utopia Room.
- Class begins September 6.

SENIOR YOUTH MINISTRY (Grades 9-12)

- Meets on Sunday at 3:30 p.m. in STM Parish Commons.
- Youth Ministry kicks off on September 10. Enrollment is required.

CONFIRMATION CLASSES (Grades 9 & 10)

- Meet on Sunday at 4:00 pm (as indicated on the Confirmation Calendar) in STM Parish Commons.
- First Confirmation Class is September 17. Confirmation students are also automatically enrolled in Senior Youth Ministry.

Once your child(ren) are enrolled, we will send you all the necessary calendars and information about the programs that apply to your particular family.
