What kind of work will we be doing?

We will serve those with needs mostly through projects such as cleaning, washing windows, minor repairs, hauling trash, yard and garden work, etc. Several projects and work sites have been established. They include projects at residences, Manhattan Catholic Schools, Habitat for Humanity, and various social service agencies.

Who will be eligible to participate?

“Go Make a Difference” is open to all including youth who will be entering 9th grade in the fall. Parents are encouraged to bring their youth to participate in this faith and work experience. All minors must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Experience will not be a major factor. There is plenty of work that needs to be done which takes little or no experience. No one will be asked to participate in projects they are not equipped to handle, but will be given the opportunity to learn new skills if they so desire.

How will the teams be organized?

Teams will be organized based on skills of the participants and the requirements of the work sites. Each project will have an on-site captain to guide the team’s work. A “runner” will be circulating among the projects to deliver necessary equipment, supplies, etc. Lunch will be provided at the work sites.

How do I register?
